

## Little Missenden Festival venues



**Venues:** Festival events normally take place in the **Church** (St John the Baptist, Little Missenden) or the **Village Hall**. It takes about 10 minutes to walk from church to village hall.

Festival teas are served on Sundays in the **School** (Little Missenden Infants).

**Pubs:** The village's two pubs (the **Red Lion** and the **Crown**) are also shown – partly as landmarks, partly as facilities for patrons.

**Toilets:** There are no public toilets in the village. There are toilets (including a disabled toilet) in the Village Hall, but not in the church. We normally station a portable toilet for patrons' use outside the church during the Festival. There are of course toilets in the pubs.

**Parking:** There is a small car park behind the Village Hall, but otherwise parking is largely on-street around the village.

**Lighting:** This is an unspoilt rural village, and there is no street lighting in many parts. Those attending evening events are advised to bring a torch.

The village lies along a road which loops off the A413 between Amersham and Great Missenden. The church's postcode is HP7 0QY.
